

What is Khanacross?

Khanacross is an introductory level motorsport event that offers an opportunity for competitors to practise their car control and judgement skills in a safe and controlled environment. The competition involves completing a program of tests in the shortest possible time without incurring penalties. The aim is to complete each test in the prescribed manner while adhering to the rules and regulations of the event.

Why should I do a Khanacross?

Khanacross events are designed to be accessible to everyone, regardless of their experience level. Drivers can compete in their own cars, provided they meet the minimum safety requirements. The purpose of these events is to provide an opportunity for beginner drivers to hone their skills and develop their abilities to handle a car at speed. It's an excellent way to build confidence and improve car control techniques in a fun and supportive environment.

How does the Khanacross series work?

The Khanacross series organised by Gold Coast Tweed Motorsporting Club typically consists of multiple events held throughout the year. Each event features a unique course layout and challenges.

Who can participate in the Khanacross series?

The Khanacross series is open to drivers aged from 12 years old to seniors of all skill levels, from novices to experienced competitors. Participants must have a valid Motorsport Australia licence or can obtain an introductory licence (GCTMC can assist with this) and adhere to the safety regulations set by the organising club.

What types of vehicles are allowed in the Khanacross series?

The Khanacross series is open to a wide range of vehicles, including standard road cars, unregistered vehicles, rally car and off-road vehicles. Vehicles must meet safety requirements outlined in the event regulations.

Your car does not need a roll cage or racing harness, however you will need to fit a Fire Extinguisher

A club vehicle is available to hire for new junior drivers 18 years old and under to come and try Khanacross.

How are points awarded in the Khanacross series?

Points are typically awarded based on a driver's finishing position in each event outright and class . The driver with the highest cumulative points at the end of the series is crowned the overall champion. See this link

What safety measures are in place during Khanacross events?

Safety is a top priority in Khanacross events. Organisers implement measures such as safety briefings, course inspections, and the presence of trained personnel to ensure a safe racing environment.

Are spectators allowed at Khanacross events?

Yes, spectators are most welcome at Khanacross events. They can enjoy watching the action from designated viewing areas while adhering to safety guidelines provided by the organisers. Spectating is free.

Do I have to provide a volunteer to help when I enter Khanacross?

Yes! Khanacross events rely on volunteers to assist with various tasks such as course setup, timing, and safety monitoring. There is a lot of flexibility and if you can't provide a volunteer for on the day of competition, there are many pre-event roles such as helping setup the track on the day prior or admin type of roles, etc. Your volunteer should use this link to register

Do I need prior experience to participate in the Khanacross Series?

No prior experience is required! The Khanacross Series welcomes participants of all skill levels, from beginners to seasoned drivers. It's a great opportunity to learn and enjoy motorsport in a safe and controlled environment.

Can participants use rally tyres in the Khanacross series?

No, the use of rally tyres is not permitted in the Khanacross series. This rule is in place at the request of landowners to protect the grounds and ensure fair competition among participants.

What type of tyres are allowed in the Khanacross series?

Participants in the Khanacross series are required to use street legal road tyres that are not aggressive in pattern. All Terrain or Mud terrain tyres are NOT allowed. Slicks or semi slicks are permitted to be used. If you are unsure, please contact the organisers for clarification.

Will food and drinks be available at the Khanacross event?

Yes, there will be a BBQ and drinks available for purchase. However, it's advisable to be self-sufficient in case supplies run out. There's also a shop approx. 10 minutes if needed.

Is alcohol permitted at the event?

No, alcohol is strictly prohibited on the property and during the event.

Can I bring pets to the event?

While we love our furry friends, as it is a working farm, for safety reasons and out of respect for other attendees, pets are not permitted at the event.

Is there any shade provided at the event?

While there are some trees available for shade, it is highly recommended for attendees to bring their own pop-up shade tent and seating, especially since the days can be hot at times.

Can I camp at the property during the Khanacross series events?

Unfortunately, camping is not allowed on the property during the Khanacross events. However, there are dedicated campgrounds nearby where you can stay.
