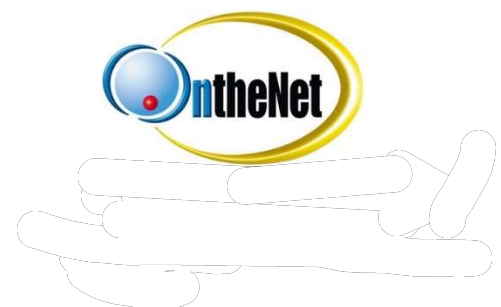
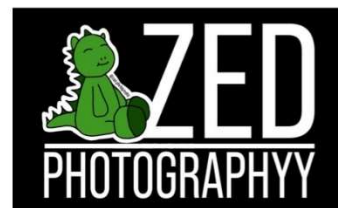

## Article 1 - Organisation

### 1.1 Overview

- The Baden Civil Southeast Queensland Khancross Series will be referred to in this document as the 'Series'. The Series is an accumulation of a maximum of five, and a minimum of four, individual Khanacross events to be conducted by the Gold Coast Tweed Motor Sporting Club Inc. in conjunction with Murwillumbah Sporting Car Club. Award winners may accumulate points over their best four events.
- The GCTMC Inc. endeavours to offer these khancross events as being family oriented where competition is invited and in a friendly atmosphere. An emphasis is placed on Junior Driver Development and support for people beginning their motorsport experience.
- However, experienced drivers are also invited to compete. This offers experienced drivers the opportunity to hone their skills between more serious events. It also allows beginning drivers to view experienced drivers in competitive vehicles displaying their skills and gauge their progress against these drivers.
- Non GCTMC members and all drivers can enter each individual event but not score points for the Series.

## 1.5 Alteration to, Abandonment or Termination of an Event or the Series

- An individual event may be altered, postponed, abandoned, or terminated at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the Event Supplementary Regulations
- The Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel an Event for reasons of force majeure. Should postponement, abandonment or cancellation occur before the close of entries the full amount of entry fees will be refunded. Should postponement, abandonment or cancellation occur after the close of entries the Promoter may refund part of the entry fee.

## Article 2 – Series Registration

### Registration to the Series is free

### 2.1 To be able to register for the Series a driver must:

- be a current financial member of the GCTMC Inc. or has submitted a paid application to become a member of the GCTMC Inc. at the time of the registration application. GCTMC Inc. membership applications can be found at: [2025 Membership | Gold Coast Tweed Motorsporting Club](#)
- hold a competition licence to comply with the Event Supplementary Regulations.
- be over the age of 12 years of age and have their parents / guardian approval on the application form
- Note Article 4.2 which clarifies the two Junior categories.
- state if they are entering as a Junior competitor (Up to and including 18 years of age during the year of competition)
- state if they are entering as a female driver.

## 2.2 Registration Limitations

For a driver to be eligible for Series Points the following criteria must be met.

- Drivers must have registered for the Series before submitting an entry for an event in the series to be eligible for Series points for that event.
- The registration may be closed when 40 registrations for the series have been reached.
- The driver **must** be a current financial member of GCTMC Inc. or have submitted a paid application form to become a member of the GCTMC Inc. at the time of the registration application.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any registration, The Organiser must advise an intending Competitor in writing if their Entry has been refused prior to the commencement of the Competition.

## 2.3 Event Entry Requirements for Drivers Registered for the Series

- Drivers are still required to complete entry documentation for each event.
- ***\*To be eligible to score points for the series, drivers are required to nominate/provide an official/volunteer for each round in which they compete (one per car). This official/volunteer may help before or during the event.\****  
***A Competitor/ their Volunteer may help with Saturday setup instead of providing a volunteer on the day.***

## Article 3 – Series Points Structure

### 3.1 Accumulating Points

- Competitors may enter all five events.
- Award winners will be an accumulation of each competitors 4 best event results.
- The driver with the most points over their best four events is deemed the winner.

## Article 4 – Series Awards Structure – Note Change to Junior class

**NOTE: All cars must only run road orientated tyres**

**\*\*No Rally, All-Terrain, Mud, Lug tyres or Hand-cut tyres. These tyres will not be accepted\*\***

### 4.1 Outright Awards

- 1<sup>st</sup> Outright – Trophy plus \$500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Outright - Trophy plus \$400
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Outright - Trophy plus \$300

### 4.2 Class Awards

- Trophy and \$100 for 1<sup>st</sup> in each Class including(G1 & G2)

B	1601cc - 2000cc
C	2001cc – 3000cc
D	3001cc and over
E	All Wheel Drive / 4WD
F	Females (2WD only)
G1	<b>Rising Stars (12-15 years)</b> Juniors (2WD naturally aspirated vehicle)
G2	<b>All Stars (16-18 Years)</b> (2WD naturally aspirated vehicle) A Junior is designated as being under nineteen (19) years of age at the beginning of the competition year.
H	Specials

Note on Juniors - **Eligibility** 12–15-year-old cut-off date 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2025

Example 1. If a competitor turns 16 on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2025 then the competitor qualifies as a (12-15) Rising Stars for the 2025 Season
